She has worked as a playwright at various theatres and has already received numerous literary prizes for her short stories and novels. In her latest successful Kulturen der Welt in Berlin. novel "Lectura fácil" (2022, German: "Leichte Sprache"), Cristina Morales takes the perspectives of four "mentally handicapped" women.
