In case that you would like to take the public transport:

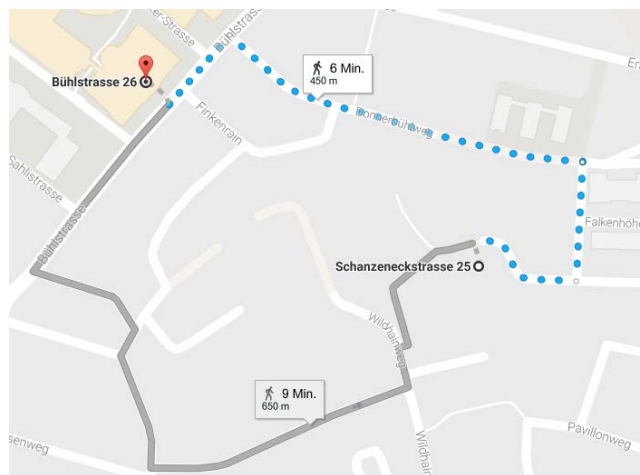
Bus number 12 from the main station stops at “Universität” or “Mittelstrasse”. From both stations it is a 5 Min walk to the Anatomy building.
